Budget, budget forecasting, and school accreditation (3 hours)

An in-depth study of various principles and practices of public school budgeting and guidance on developing an annual budget calendar and holding a budget hearing. Course will provide an overview of accreditation standards to ensure budget is aligned accordingly.

School law for business managers (2 hours)
